To do that I visited approx 20 supermarkets and shops specialized in Bretons cookies. Nowhere could I find the famous box. Therefore, as the number printed on the roof looks like a telephone number I rang. I got in touch with the company who had this brilliant conditioning idea, but (alas!) this box of traou mads is no longer manufactured.

As I cannot compete with Daryl's performing engines and boats, I had loved motorizing a slow boat powered by a low frequency pop-pop engine. But, the cookie box being unavailable, I decided to build a more realistic fishing boat. Here is the result:



Hull length: 30cm. And inside there is a slow speed engine. (Big volume, large diaphragm and long pipes).



Target reached: slow speed engine, slow speed boat and loud pop-pops.
